### Footnotes

FUZZY'S STORY vied outside, took over, turned back a bid from the runner up and drew clear, driving. THEONEMUGGZ stalked early, moved up on the turn, bid three wide at the quarter pole and came up second best. RONNIE THE BARBER raced off the pace, came three wide into the lane and lacked a rally. FIRST AND BAY was bumped at the start and closed belatedly outside. PERFECT SON raced inside, was steadied at the furlong marker and weakened. PUMA'S BLUFF was bumped at the start, raced between rivals into the stretch and failed to threaten. DONABILITY vied inside and tired.
