**Footnotes**

THE CROONER was bumped after the start, tracked inside, moved up three wide past the half, bid three wide midway on the turn, took charge turning for home and drew away under urging. INVISIBLE STAR vied inside and was no match for the winner. FORLOUIE broke out bumping THE CROONER, settled off the pace, moved up three wide on the far turn and rallied mildly outside. MASQUED TSAAR raced three wide into the clubhouse turn, then saved ground, came four wide into the lane and lacked a rally. PROLIFIC stalked the pace, moved up four wide past the half, chased and tired. JUNGLELAND vied two wide, then between rivals and faded.
