LITCHFIELD HILLS stalked pace inside, split horses upper stretch and was up in late yards. SOAP OPERA pressed pace outside, led into final furlong and fought gamely. DOCTORESSA dwelt, rallied four wide into stretch, lost ground and closed well. REHEARSE, three wide turns, stalked pace, bid upper stretch and fought gamely. BAGASSE rallied between horses second turn and finished well. ACTRESS, middle of pack, finished with good energy. EXOTIC STRANGER hard used to gain command, led to final furlong and weakened. MATTIE KATE saved ground and had no rally. CHISPA DE ORO steadied between horses after three furlongs and lacked a rally. J. T.'S JET LINER bore out into first turn, went three wide turns and had no rally. ELEKTRONA bore out first turn, went four wide turns and had no rally. CORY'S COMET, middle of pack, was in tight quarter pole and gave way.
