ROARING FEVER rated in good position just off the rail, advanced to the lead nearing the quarter pole, dueled clear midstretch then widened slightly with steady insistence. LONG TERM SUCCESS rated the pace inside, contested the final turn, dueled close through the upper stretch, yielded the last eighth but held on well for place. LAST INTENTION rated off the pace about the four path, made his bid toward the quarter pole then finished evenly. TAMBURELLO (CHI), unhurried to the final turn, bid widest at the quarter pole, closed mildly then leveled off. ONE NICE CAT rated off the pace inside, waited for room toward the rail on the final turn, bid entering the stretch but leveled off late. MAX FOREVER was reluctant to load then bobbled a stride out, stayed with the pace two deep, contested between rivals nearing the quarter pole then gave way entering the stretch.
