**Footnotes**

TRIPLE X. rated off the pace inside, eased around the pacesetter leaving the final turn, gradually reached the front under a hard drive then edged ahead through the closing yards. TUNE OF THE SPIRIT was quickly clear to rate the pace inside, pressured into the lane then outfished through the final yards. SIDETRACK rated off the pace two deep, gave chase into the final turn then had no stretch response. NATIONALISTIC (IRE), unhurried off the rail, bid three wide into the final turn and had some mild outside lane gain. HE FLIES rated off the pace in mid track, gave chase into the final turn then weakened in the stretch. VIVE LA VIE saved ground while off the pace and weakened. BOASTFUL was unhurried off the rail and had no rally. L'ARGENTO rated off the pace about the three path then weakened on the final turn. POPPA'S FAVORITES was outrun.
