POLLY'S FOLLY advanced to a short lead to set the early pace in mid track, lost some ground entering the stretch then came back dueling the final furlong and drew clear in late yards. CASHMERE AND SILK had a short brief lead early, stayed with the pace toward the inside, moved clear entering the stretch, duelled the final furlong then yielded seventy yards out. LOVELY CANDLES chased the pace in the four path then finished evenly. FLAG THE MINT DOWN showed no speed, came through the turn in mid track and proved empty for the drive. CALL OUT gave chase from the outside then offered no rally. THE CANDY QUEEN and BON APPEAL were outrun.
