TANGIER SOUND vied outside for the early lead, took over and angled towards the rail on the turn, responded when roused and drew clear under urging. NUN ON THE RUN raced close up on the inside, bid outside of TANGIER SOUND passing the quarter pole and proved second best in the lane. WITH PATIENCE raced well off the early pace, rallied inside, split foes passing the sixteenth marker and finished willingly. AMBER'S WAY saved ground, came out for the drive and failed to sustain a bid. TWICE AS SWEET raced between foes and lacked a rally. MULTIPLE WINS raced three and four wide, then lacked a rally. IMPOLITE vied inside and tired. CHARM A SONG raced three wide and did not factor. OH SAY VICKI chased three wide and faded. CASING saved ground and did not factor.
