CIGNO D'ORO broke outward making contact with Totally Precious, advanced to the lead rating the pace inside, maintained control under firmly held reins through the turn then finished willingly under steady stretch pressure. TOTALLY PRECIOUS was bumped at the start, kept within range of the lead off the rail, held aim to finish well but was not good enough. PICKIN LAUREL chased the pace about the four path and finished evenly. I'MTOOGOODTOETRUE was bumped at the start, picked up the chase toward the rail and finished evenly. EASTERN GALE chased the pace toward mid track but had nothing left in the drive. SUMMER STING broke inward bumping I'mtoogoodtoetrue, gave chase widest then tired leaving the turn. JENNY BEAN GIRL showed no speed then no rally.
