WILD PALM, unhurried early, rallied three wide second turn and was up in final strides. ELEGANT APRIL, four wide turns, bid after half, led quarter pole and weakened. JUDGE SARAH dueled inside into final sixteenth and weakened. MY DEAR ABBY, four wide first turn, went three wide second turn bidding for the lead and weakened in midstretch. MISS LUVVER, well placed, went four wide second turn and tired. OMLET, three wide turns, bid after half and gave way upper stretch. CAVAMARIE set pace between horses for five furlongs and gave way.
