CAMACTHMAGNIFICENT set the pace on the inside and drew clear under steady pressure. BYTHEBEAUTIFULSEA was bumped at the start, chased two wide and finished well to best the others. BABY BUZZ was bumped at the start, saved ground and rallied mildly on the rail. HERMOSILLO stalked the pace, bid three wide between rivals and weakened. STRAITFROMTHEHEART broke in bumping OK THIS WAY at the start, bid four wide midway on the turn and weakened. MIZZOU TIGER saved ground and lacked a rally. OK THIS WAY was bumped at the start, raced off the rail and failed to respond. FINANCE MASTER bobbled and was bumped at the start, then outrun.
