LOUDERTHANTHUNDER stumbled badly leaving the gate, raced four wide the opening turn, stalked the pace two deep most of the backstretch, moved to the lead approaching the quarter pole and dug in determinedly to fend off the next two finishers. TWO SONS rated off the pace about the four path, took aim nearing the quarter pole and dueled gamely through the stretch for place while outfinished for the win. WILLIAM PALEY rated off the pace off the rail, started his drive angling four wide from the five sixteenths pole then outfinished in the duel for place. PERKY JUGE settled back off the rail, angled outward through the final turn, entered the stretch widest and leveled off from there. FIRST AND BAY rated a slim lead inside, gave chase into the final turn but weakened from the five sixteenths pole. PUMA'S BLUFF saved ground off the pace, eased out on the final turn and had no rally. SHUGA CAT showed no speed off the rail and had no significant bid. BIG BULLY was outrun. STORM'S DILEMMA saved ground.
