UPHILL SKIER hustled up to the lead early then rated the pace off the rail, responded well to pressure when challenged at the quarter pole and was drawing away late under steady handling. OUT OF THE WILL rated close to the lead in the four path, proved no match for the winner and chased her through the stretch. SONIA'S SONG kept up from the outside, dropped back in the five path on the turn and finished evenly. FALSE SIGNAL showed no speed toward the outside, was six wide on the turn and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. DUSTY EVENING chased the pace from the outside, was in the five path through the turn and empty in the stretch. BEST INTERVIEW chased the pace toward the inside then tired on the rail. CRYPTOFEM chased the pace, was in the three path on the turn and empty in the drive. TAMAYAZ GAL chased the pace to the turn then weakened in the four path. CLOSETS N' CLOTHES bobbled at the start and was through early.
