A DREAM TO FOLLOW was kept just off the pace in the four path, dueled from the top of the stretch and gradually edged clear the final strides. DEVIL'S CHASM was kept just off the pace inside, dueled from the top of the stretch and reluctantly yielded the final yards. CAMEO'S COVERGIRL rated back saving ground, started her bid midway through the turn, closed inside to late stretch, angled out and finished evenly. ANNA BEGINS raced five and six wide then finished evenly drifting slightly in. JOSIE showed no speed in mid track then finished outside. WELL PROTECTED never factored. PUGSLY drew clear early setting the pace off the rail then faded under pressure from the top of the stretch. JOYEUX NOEL was steadied early on, moved to contention in the four path, lost some momentum entering the stretch, was steadied late then not abused.
