MARQUIS JET chased the pace about the three path, closed for the lead three thirty seconds out and drew away from the sixteenth pole. WAR TORN chased the pace off the rail, lost ground through the turn and lasted for place. CHIPS ARE DOWN, slow into stride, eased out through the upper stretch and was closing steadily. NAN'S REAL LOVE set a pressured pace two deep, dropped back into the lane then weakened a furlong out. ARMSTRONG WON chased the pace from the inside then eased out while leveling off in the lane. CINEMUD contested the pace while alternating for the lead, dug in with a slim advantage through the upper stretch then gave way approaching the sixteenth pole. BLOWOUT never factored. PRIVATE WISH gave chase toward mid track and faded after the opening quarter.
