Footnotes

GOLDEN ARTEMIS rated the pace inside, was urged for run leaving the final turn and held on well with steady insistence. BATTERY OPERATED, unhurried early, started her advance after the opening half mile and finished strong. BOBBY'S BELL stalked the pace off the rail, held aim through the final turn then leveled off in the lane. THE MULES SISTER rated off the pace off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole and had little left in the lane. COCOSETTE faded after the opening half mile. OUR AUNT ADELINE, off the pace about the three path, weakened losing ground through the final turn. MOSTLY PEACE hesitated then lunged at the break and never factored.
