G'DAY G'DAY rated nicely, rallied and drew clear two fences out, urged on strongly under a hand ride to wire. AERO rated nicely, rallied to contend three fences out, but was unable to close gap in the stretch. MUSIC TO MY EARS (IRE) moved from second to take the lead on the last circuit, overtaken three fences out and weakened in stretch. I'M TELLING was away alertly to an early fifteen length lead, erred at fence in front of judges stand starting the final circuit, soon after dropped out of contention. CHESS BOARD (GB) was never a factor, and was pulled up three fences out.
