CUSE opened up a commanding lead from the start, the field closed the gap three fences from home, CUSE took off again and cruised to the wire. MISCHIEF trailed the field for the first circuit, made steady progress on the backside for the final time, rallied after jumping the last to take the second spot. FINAL STRAW was always in contention, got close to the leader three jumps from home but lacked substance in the final strides. EXTRAEXTRAORDINARY was unhurried early, made a mild bid on the backstretch for the final time but could not gain further ground. EBANOUR (IRE) was in contention until the final jump then stopped. ED'S BIG BET ran evenly throughout and was no factor. OREBANKS had a mild rally going to the last and flattened out from there. SUMO POWER was through after a mile and a half. ON THE CORNER raced mid pack until the second last then fell back. EAGLE BEAGLE was through after a mile, fell back and was pulled up before the last jump. CLASS BRAHMS was never in contention, trailed and was pulled up before the last jump. CLASS CLASSIC fell at the fifth jump.
