ROSE N ANGELINA sent clear from the break, allowed to relax posting slow splits to the far turn, set down in upper stretch, had rivals measured holding clear late. SAMEE BRASS hustled out following ROSE N ANGELINA into the backside, loomed off rival into the far turn, set down abreast rivals in upper stretch, went all out to salvage place. I HEAR THAT came away well, tracked a slow pace down the backside, kept inside when bidding from the 1/4 pole, closed the gap under a stiff drive to vie willingly to wire. VIVA BLANDA unhurried when in close at the break, saved ground down the backside, moved to leaders inside the 1/4 pole, vied from rail in drive, bogged down late. ELLENSBURG away slowly, varied little down the backside, swung 5 wide into the far turn, set down at mid track, gave even response in drive. PRETTY CAT dropped back early, raced along the inside, showed some belated interest. OUR LEGEND raced evenly in second flight, proved no factor. TRIPP WIRE away slowly, asked for response leaving the backside, had no meaningful response. DOBIES LITTLE GIRL moved evenly off the inside, wavered into the far turn giving way.
