Footnotes

VICTORIA'S IMAGE sent hard, was involved in a three way duel for the lead, raced along the rail on the turn and into the stretch, went clear at the eighth pole and drew off under a drive. DAD SAYS YES was off a bit awkwardly, raced off the rail, roused and gained momentum near the quarter pole, swung seven wide into the stretch, was under left handed stick and ducked out mid stretch, the rider switched hands and finished very strong at the wire. ITS TUESDAY rushed from the gate, vied early racing four wide, chased the winner into the lane, was out finished late and settled for the show position in a game effort. PINWINEE WHISKEY raced evenly throughout, roused at the three eighths pole, gave a mild bid but was no threat. QUEENOFTHETINKERS was outrun early, asked past the quarter pole, angled top of the stretch under a drive, found a belated stride and finished with interest. SEPTEMBER DAWN sent hard, dueled while between rivals on the turn, vied to top of the lane, gave way mid stretch, used up. IRISH OF DOBBIN tracked from off the rail, roused mid turn, gave no response, never menaced. PIXIE DUST hustled and flashed brief speed, chased on the turn, gave way in upper stretch.
