PATRIOT SPIRIT broke alert to clear into the opening turn, would set all the pace racing off the inside while holding sway between horses late. OLD DUKE PUFFER dropped back early went unhurried finding stride leaving the far turn, gave steady surge along the inside to grab PLAYING LIT for place in the last yards. PLAYING LIT forwardly placed tracked a soft pace traveling evenly on the inside to the far turn, gave a roused move there angling out to loom abreast PATRIOT SPIRIT in upper stretch, put to a stiff drive would hang the final sixteenth. DONE DEAL sent up early would back off rating to the half then cut the corner to bid from the rail in upper stretch, quickly lost momentum leveling off the final eighth. BROKE US hustled close up from the break followed PATRIOT SPIRIT through the backside, wavered on the far turn dropping off while swinging to mid track in upper stretch, failed to recover under a brisk drive. PROUD NIGHT tucked inside early saved ground throughout while proving no menace. FEROCIOUS played no factor. PRIVATE ISLE went evenly tracking the pace through the far turn then tired in upper stretch. ACTUARY'S SON gave a sluggish effort. RAYWICK was done early.
