Footnotes

BEAR BACK set a pressured pace, dueled while between foes from upper stretch, lost the lead briefly in mid stretch, dug in under strong handling to surge late to retake the lead in last strides. ROY MASSIAH was always placed racing just off the winner, almost drew even mid stretch, could never get by in the drive, saved place position in game effort. I'MMEANONTHEGREEN stalked the pace under a rating, rallied while angling to the rail entering the stretch, vied along the rail in a three way duel, put a head in front briefly mid stretch, was out finished coming to the wire, failed late in hard effort. WHERE'S CHARLIE rated early, roused mid turn, came four wide into the lane, chased duelers under a drive, needed more late, bested rest. NINE BALLADS hustled along, sat patient to mid turn, came wide entering the stretch, failed to threaten despite being hard ridden. THERMOPYLAE trailed racing along the rail throughout, mounted bid near the quarter pole, leveled off from mid stretch, no real threat. STRIKINGLY was hustled to race up close briefly, dropped off going down the backside, came six wide upper stretch under a drive, failed to factor. SEAMAN FIRST CLASS tracked to the half, asked mid turn, lacked response, faded in upper stretch. SHANNON THE CANNON was always outrun, never involved. DAKOTA FREEWAY lacked speed, gave way mid turn, raced wide from upper stretch, well beaten in dull effort.
