THANKOURLUCKYSTARS sent hard, pursued 4 wide backside, extended on turn, gaining. REASON TO BE ASTAR went evenly, prompted from 1/2, belated response, closed in. FESTIVITIES slow early, angled out, mild rally in drive. RAINBOW MISS slow early, saved ground, proved no menace. SIBER BLUE slow early, no factor. ANNIE WARBUCKS always outrun. MISS BREAK AWAY early speed, chased pace, tired. DESERT WELLS hustled along, through after 1/2.
