Footnotes

OUR VALENTINA rushed to set all the pace, raced towards the inside throughout, drew off from mid stretch under intermittent urging. TEMPTING NATASHA raced evenly in second flight, advanced near the quarter pole, rallied for the place position but never threatened the winner. QUIET MIST traveled towards the rail on the turn, hard ridden into the lane, rallied willingly. PREY OF THE CAT hustled and chased the winner early on, lacked needed bid and weakened at the eighth pole. PARTY REGENT well placed throughout, traveled mid track, was pushed out slightly by VALENTINE entering the stretch, lacked late kick. VALENTINE showed good early foot, chased from the quarter pole, drifted out entering the stretch, tired in the drive. TERESIA was bumped hard at the break when UP THE ACCOUNT broke outward, offered little. UP THE ACCOUNT broke out and slammed TERESIA at the start, hustled to mid pack while running wide on the turn, gave way in upper stretch, no factor. SMOOTH SURFACE was slow early, raced wide, never involved.
