Footnotes

GLITTERING CHAD was unhurried and raced well off the rail for the run down the backstretch, rallied 4 wide at the 3/8 pole, engaged MARY SWAN past the 1/4 pole, dueled outside that rival to the 1/16 pole, went clear under a dive. MARY SWAN came out in full stride to get a clear advantage in the opening quarter, raced clear on the turn, was headed entering the stretch, dug in and fought to the 1/16 pole, ceded grudgingly and proved second best. A LITTLE GOLD was unhurried early, angled out mid turn, roused and was under a stiff dive to get up for show in deep stretch. MOSTLY DEVIOUS showed speed and raced off the rail, chased entering the stretch under an all out drive, lacked rally. TURN A PROFITT was hustled to track from the inside, was hard ridden top of the lane and gave a mild response. GRAMMA JO'S PRIDE had no speed, angled out near the 1/4 pole, came 5 wide into the lane, finished evenly. LILIANA L raced wide throughout, asked but gave no response. SILKYENCE sent hard and showed brief speed while 4 wide, chased on the turn and weakened top of the lane. BEEDA hustled and did flash speed early while between rivals, dropped to the inside on the turn and gave way near the 1/4 pole.
