PARKER VALLEY sent hard pressed to a short lead on the turn, dug in through the stretch holding up gamely. IRON WILLFUL hustled out pressed then chased the pace to upper stretch, surged gamely late only to be denied. PETERS BLUE WAY stalked close up through the turn, loomed down the stretch vying willingly near mid track. NEED MONEY DAD broke slowly, was hustled between foes, angled inside to upper stretch, hung in drive. FAVORITE PASSION rushed off the pace, had a modest gain through the stretch. MILLENNIUMMILLIONS lost ground proving no factor. AFTER PARTY off slowly was always outrun. B L'S SHOCKER raced wide to stretch then gave way. SHADOW FAX pressed early then gave way. CONSTANT VELOCITY flashed early speed then stopped on the turn, was eased in upper stretch.
