Footnotes

AT THE KNEES moved on pace following WHITE FLAME close up to the far turn, engaged for the lead there surging clear in upper stretch then widened from the rail late. EVERYMAN unhurried early gave a roused move on the far turn, had steady surge down the lane clearing late for place. SOCA TEMPO rated back early gave a prompted move on the far turn, responded willingly under a drive gaining position late. WHITE FLAME sent up for the early lead was worked on pace down the backside, collared on the far turn would wear under pressure fading off from the eighth pole. SAVTHELASDANCEFOME stalked through the backside then engaged for the lead on the far turn, failed to sustain the effort flattening out in upper stretch. THUNDER ANEES raced evenly in second flight through the backside, moved to leaders on the far turn then leveled off in upper stretch. CAN'T BE PETE stalked through the backside then bid all out on the far turn, would wilt in upper stretch. TERRIFIC STORM failed to compete.
