SPLENDID ONE vied while between rivals to the half, raced inside of ACTOR'S GUILD from mid turn as these two opened up margin on the field, asked for more upper stretch, responded to draw off as much the best. ACTOR'S GUILD pressed the winner for six furlongs, proved no match from mid stretch, gamely held the place position. EXTREME MISSILE rated from the start, traveled at mid track, asked on the bend, made a willing move but was no threat to the winner. DUBAI CITY stumbled at the break, lagged to mid turn, asked and swung six wide into the lane, improved placing but was no factor. FASTER THAN INDY tracked the pace while saving ground, asked for more mid turn, gave no response, no threat. BALLACOLLA rushed and pressed the pace while five to six wide to the half, began to chase on the turn, gave way upper stretch. ROCKET BOOSTER broke alertly, set the early pace while off the rail, headed nearing the half mile marker, gave way leaving the quarter pole and stopped in upper stretch, spent.
