**Footnotes**

CRY OF THE CAT sent up to engage HAMA'S on the pace, moved on the inside of rival to the far turn, roused to go clear near the 1/4 pole, took charge under a brisk hand ride down the lane. HAMA'S hustled for the early lead, pressed along abreast CRY OF THE CAT to the far turn, extended going in tandem outside the 1/4 pole, was overpowered ceding to rival at the top of the lane, kept to task finishing a clear second best. FORTY GRAND unhurried from the break, varied little racing to the 1/2, roused to action on the far turn, gave an even move 4 wide into the lane, was no match for the top pair outbidding others. MEADOW MOUNTAIN dropped well back early, labored to the 1/2 mile pole, circled out 8 wide into upper stretch, gave even stride under a hard drive to pass rest. GREELEYSCHOICE couldn't go with the early pace, varied little to the stretch proving no factor. THESTORMHASCLEARED was never involved. TIME TO RUSH hustled to go close up, angled out once reaching the backside, loomed abreast rivals into the far turn, came under a drive nearing the 1/4 pole, was worn out at the head of the lane giving way. MACKINAW ISLAND worked from the break, stalked under use down the backside, extended to bid going hard to the 1/4 pole, gave way along the inside in drive. STORM OF THE WEST raced evenly at mid pack to the far turn, flattened out near the 1/4 pole.
