MISS BONN BONN broke alertly engaging ALL THAT SASS on the early pace, moved clear into the turn keeping an eye on FASHIONABLY LITE racing to the 1/4 pole, turned away rival opening margin in upper stretch, remained with plenty left winning much the best. FASHIONABLY LITE a step slow leaving the gate was quickly hustled to the front end, tried MISS BONN BONN going hard through the turn, rebuffed by rival in upper stretch, kept to task after finishing clearly second best. HUNTERS RAE away slow, was outrun through the turn, set down at mid track in upper stretch, responded with good late action. JILL MCGILL raced evenly from the gate, saved ground through the turn, set down at rail inside the 1/4 pole, posed no late threat. LITTLE SOLDIERGIRL outrun early, labored along near the back, circled out 6 wide at the top of the lane, picked up tired ones late. THIS IS IT a step slow early, was rushed through the turn, made up little ground there, came up empty in drive. LILIANA L was never involved. PERSIAN'S SURPRISE hustled on the outside, pursued 4 wide on the turn, came 5 wide into lane, gave way in drive. ALL THAT SASS broke sharply to the early lead, overpowered from the inside by MISS BONN BONN into the turn, chased that one to the 1/4 pole before folding up. SHENNY labored throughout.
