WILD PURSUIT went evenly to upper stretch, took aim abreast rival, got up on the wire. MAJOR STRIKE came away alertly, set a clear pace to upper stretch, hooked late would just miss. AL'S CROW saved ground, moved to bid in upper stretch, angled out in drive, hung late. PREMIER COURT sent hard chased through the turn then weakened in drive. BAND OF THIEVES raced wide failing to menace. GALLANT SOLDIER raced second flight, played no factor. KYLE'S TREASURY raced wide while always outrun. CLINT'S CAT was never involved. TIME COUNTER had brief speed then gave way on the turn. SAY YES DEAR had brief foot then faded on the turn.
