Footnotes

WIN MACHINE pressured the pace through the turn shaking off IDE BETTER PRAY to take over in upper stretch, kept to brisk urging would widen late. GUN START pressured early then steadied when in close near the seven sixteenths pole, regrouped while angling to the four path in upper stretch coming on to save place. IDE BETTER PRAY sent hard pressured the pace moving abreast WIN MACHINE through the turn, dispatched by the winner in upper stretch would wear down in the three path. ALERT N READY slow early lost ground coming nine wide in upper stretch giving an even finish. UPTONOW away slowly trailed the field into upper stretch angling out to the six path there passing tired ones. FLEET RIDE raced evenly in mid pack playing no factor. CITY BEAR was always outrun. CHIQUITO KISSES gave way on the turn. INAMORATO'S TALE saved ground wilting near the rail the final eighth. An objection from the rider of GUN START against the rider of WIN MACHINE for interference near the seven sixteenths pole was disallowed by the stewards.
