Footnotes

PROMETHEUS raced evenly off the pace through the turn responding to threaten from the four path in upper stretch, ran past a weary pacesetter late. GAME CHANGER broke sharply to the early lead widening on pace into upper stretch, digging in from the three path became leg weary and was run down late. OVER QUALIFIED laid close up stalking GAME CHANGER through the turn into upper stretch, extending in the three path could find no late surge. SIX MILLER'S slow early saved ground through the turn, drifted from the two to the six path down the stretch passing tired ones in the process. HOMERSRUN varied little racing in mid pack. NELLA'S MANGAS was never involved racing six wide through the stretch. GIN KINGS chased the pace before wavering on the turn giving way from the quarter pole. UNEXPECTEDDIVIDEND was hustled in pursuit through the turn then wilted in the four path upper stretch. CASANOVA GIANT struggled throughout.
