WHISKEY REBELLION quickly gained the lead, set all the pace racing two wide, received a couple of left handed cracks of the whip top of the stretch, responded to draw off for a convincing victory being ridden out late. CHIEF MANGO was a step slow leaving the gate, rushed up between foes going into the far turn, chased the winner from the quarter pole, never threatened and dug in at the wire to save second place. SHANNON'S BEAU well placed from the start, bid four wide at the quarter pole, was slowly gaining on the runner up nearing the wire but had to settle for third best in a willing effort. HACHI hustled from the gate but lacked early foot, raced evenly along the inside, angled out mid stretch, needed more late besting rest. MY FRIEND STEVE trailed to the quarter pole, angled out five wide under a drive upper stretch, showed belated interest but never threatened. I'M ALL SPOTTED UP pressed the winner to mid turn racing three wide, began to drop off in upper stretch, no late factor. BAIL BONDSMAN lacked speed racing towards the rear throughout, offered little. RED FRANCHISE flashed brief speed running along the rail, faded from the three sixteenths.
