Footnotes

LION'S REIGN rushed into the far turn, dueled abreast rivals on the bend racing four wide, moved clear in upper stretch, widened in the final furlong being ridden out. WINBLAISEANDSHOW unhurried early trailing to the quarter pole, swung five wide upper stretch, closed willingly securing second place but never threatened the winner. HENNEPIN COUNTY vied briefly in a four way duel for the lead, dropped off some past the quarter pole and chased form upper stretch racing along the rail, was outfinished late and settled for third place in a good effort. GHOST HILL sent hard from the gate, held a slight lead to the quarter pole, proved no match for mid stretch and weakened to the wire. SEASIDE NATIVE raced evenly running four to five wide throughout, lacked response despite being hard ridden in the lane. TURBO TIM raced along the rail in the second flight throughout, failed to factor. HOT MINUTE flashed brief foot dueling for the early lead, gave way leaving the quarter pole and broke down falling top of the stretch.
