**Footnotes**

ACEINTHESKY stalked close up gaining on the turn, dueled to the lead in upper stretch then edged clear in the three path. BYESVILLE a step slow early surged to even terms three deep in upper stretch, extending in the four path ceded grudgingly late. OPPORTUNITY TO RUN slow early surged along the inside to upper stretch, dueling in the two path came up a bit short. NOBLE ONE sent hard pressured the pace through the turn, wavered in upper stretch fading near the rail. RUNNINGONLOVE slow early played no factor. OVERPOWER pressured the pace dueling through the turn, wilted in the two path upper stretch. SIR WILLIAM giving way on the turn was eased to the wire.
