Footnotes

SCHECTER hustled leaving the gate and angled to the rail, set a pressured pace throughout, dug in under strong handling form upper stretch, just lasted being fully extended. NORTHERN RANSOM moved to the rail shortly after the start, angled to mid track leaving the quarter pole, came four wide top of the lane, surged belatedly missing for the win but get up for second place in a willing manner. BODEY THE BEAST tracked to mid turn, bid three wide at the quarter pole, came inward in upper stretch causing the rider of MILITARY LIGHT to steady briefly, almost drew even with SCHECTER with a furlong to go, would hang late being outfinished racing between foes to the wire losing second place in final jumps. RUNNINGINFLIPFLOPS settled in the second flight, rallied four to five wide from mid stretch, finished with interest besting rest. THE BROW raced up close soon after the start running along the rail, was briefly in tight top of the lane and angled out for room, gave chase under a drive but lacked rally flattening out from mid stretch. CHIPPED tracked to the far turn running between foes, angled out near the three eighths pole under a drive, failed to respond never threatening. DECISIVE CALL trailed soon after the start racing wide, did improve position but never threatened. MILITARY SAM stalked the pressed the winner at the quarter pole, vied briefly in a three way battle entering the stretch traveling between foes, was in tight and steadied briefly when BODEY THE BEAST came inward, gave way from mid stretch. BLUE LIGHT lacked speed, gave way entering the stretch. JACK VA VITE chased to the quarter pole, dropped off in upper stretch finishing well beaten.
