SETTOP tracked early following LORD CANELA through the turn, took aim abreast foe surging clear in the two path. LORD CANELA pressured the pace shaking clear on the turn, digging in from the rail down the lane was no match for SETTOP late. RYANS JOY hustled out pursued early then dropped off the leaders on the turn, raced evenly in the three path down the stretch holding the others safe. GLASS AGE slow early gained a bit in the four path upper stretch finishing evenly. MAXOPICO away slowly trailed through the turn, swung six wide in upper stretch picked up some tired ones. SUNDAY MISSILE played no factor. STORMY DUDE was never involved. JUST CALL ME ROCKY offered little. DANGER DANGER pressed early then wavered on the turn giving way to upper stretch. WHEELER DEALER a step slow in mid pack flattened out to upper stretch.
