Footnotes

BELLE OF ASCOT broke alert grabbing the lead then moving off on pace going well clear to upper stretch, became leg weary in the closing yards reaching the wire in time. SAINT SCHIFTY was bumped hard and jostled by DAMARA missing the break, recovered out of the turn emerging off a loose BELLE OF ASCOT in upper stretch, angled abreast the tiring leader late needing one more stride. KLINSMAN'S LUCK pressed then chased BELLE OF ASCOT through the turn angling to mid track in upper stretch, began to waver under the whip holding position late. COLERAINE bumped in a chain reaction at the break would labor through the turn, mustered a mild response down the lane to move past others. SCALD was never involved. FANCY RIDE pressed then chased through the turn, would fold into upper stretch. DEVILSGONNAGETCHA was always outrun. DAMARA bore in jamming rivals at the break. UNACCOUNTABLY PINK was bumped hard in a chain reaction at the break laboring after.
