ISLAND SKY slow early saved ground to mid turn, swung out into upper stretch finding stride from the seven path surging up in the closing strides. DRAW PLAY sat close up stalking FLY BY MOONLIGHT through the turn, engaged abreast rival in upper stretch taking a late lead only to cede to wide pressure from ISLAND SKY in the closing yards. FLY BY MOONLIGHT broke sharply setting a clear pace through the turn, collared in upper stretch would wear down. STASH THE BOOTS raced evenly throughout lacking a contending surge. DAKOTA FREEWAY was never involved. CHALLENGER veered in a bit at the break, labored through the turn angling to mid track in upper stretch, threatened briefly then flattened under a drive. MOVING ON THE WIND veered steadying briefly at the break laboring after. TONAKA struggled throughout.
