Footnotes

TRUST LUC well placed from the start, advanced three wide at the three eighths pole to race abreast a pair of rivals, drove clear entering the stretch, increased margin from mid stretch under steady handling. OLYMPIC STREET broke alertly, dueled outside of IRISH GENTLEMAN soon after the start, vied for the lead mid turn running between foes, ceded stubbornly from mid stretch gamely holding onto second place. IRISH GENTLEMAN showed good early foot, battled for the lead running along the rail throughout, tired near the sixteenth pole in a good effort. HE'S A DIXIE BOY tracked around the bend, came four wide turning for home taking aim on duelers, lacked needed sure besting rest. BUDDHA CAN DANCE lacked speed racing towards the inside, showed belated interest improving placing in the lane but never menaced. PHILLY FRENZY raced five to six wide down the backside, failed to respond when roused, no threat. IFPUSHCOMESTOSHOVE settled in mid pack racing along the inside, swung wide under a stiff drive upper stretch, lacked needed bid. MIDNIGHT BREAK varied little racing mid track throughout. DAKOTA FREEWAY lacked speed running along the rail throughout, showed little. SIMPLY BOLD was always outrun racing wide throughout.
