PERPETUITY hustled on the outside wrested the lead on the turn then widened into upper stretch, kept to task from the eighth pole held firm in the two path. AVA'S CHARM pressured early then dropped off on the turn, angled to mid track in upper stretch responded closing willingly late. MADAME ALI slow early advanced on the turn, extending in the four path upper stretch gave an even finish. PROUDTOBYOURFRIEND away slowly trailed through the turn, taken seven wide in upper stretch gave a modest rally to improve position. SPANISH SALSA gave hard pursuit through the turn into upper stretch wearing down late in the two path. WHO'S THAT ONE was hustled between horses through the turn, tired in mid stretch. FULLY EXPOSED breaking sharply set the early pace, hooked on the turn would fold in upper stretch. GITTIN COMFY pressured early then gave way on the turn.
