CAPE HATCHET stalked STROLL WITH ME from the start saving ground, came thru along the inside top of the lane when that rival remained off the rail, slowly edged clear under a stiff drive, held safe late holding off SHAMELESS RISK nearing the finish line. SHAMELESS RISK stalked early on, bid three wide upper stretch, was closing in on the winner coming to the wire but missed in a hard effort. TAXICAB settled in the second flight, rallied four wide upper stretch, finished willingly securing third place. STROLL WITH ME broke alertly setting the pace traveling off the rail, headed by the winner in upper stretch, battled to the sixteenth pole then shortened stride. DELAWARE SLEW trailed mid turn running towards the inside, angled out upper stretch, showed belated interest in deep stretch but never factored. JET FLAG trailed early, swung five wide top of the lane under a stiff drive, failed to menace. MORE HUMOR well placed around the bend, raced three wide top of the lane giving chase, lacked bid and weakened in the drive. B. MURRAY moved to the rail shortly after the start, faded past the quarter pole and gave way mid stretch finishing well beaten.
