GUNNERY SERGEANT away slowly fired four wide on the far turn moving clear at mid track in upper stretch, in charge from the eighth pole was hand ridden home. RED TWENTY TWO stalked then pressured SHICAGO SENSATION on pace through the far turn, overpowered by GUNNERY SERGEANT to upper stretch would need all late to salvage place. BOLTEN N STREAKIN raced evenly to the far turn, gave a mild rally into upper stretch bidding all out from mid track late. KARLENS outrun to upper stretch showed belated response. YES IT IS raced evenly off the pace before wearing down into upper stretch. CHEYCONS REVENGE was never involved. SHICAGO SENSATION was sent to the top working the pace under pressure through the far turn, would wilt into upper stretch. SPADA SCURA was bumped around at the break, never reached contention before tiring.
