COUNTRY HUMOR rushed shortly after the start and vied in a three way battle for the lead, held position along the rail around the turn, began to edge away from upper stretch, increased margin under steady handling to the wire. IRISH GENTLEMAN broke outward bothering TWOFIVESLEW leaving the gate, hustled up to track a contested pace, swung four wide entering the lane, surged late securing the place position in a willing effort. DARKSIDE HOLIDAY showed good speed pressing the winner soon after the start, put a head in front at the quarter pole, could not keep pace from mid stretch and was outgamed in deep stretch missing second place. HOLY THURSDAY settled early and angled to the rail, showed belated action running along the rail in deep stretch but was no real threat. TWOFIVEFIVESLEW was bothered and steadied briefly leaving the gate when IRISH GENTLEMAN broke outward, raced in the second flight and between rivals, varied little never menacing. SNOWBOARD RIDGE hustled early, raced abreast foes vying for the lead at the quarter pole, began to weaken inside the eighth pole. U S TREASURY was moved well off the rail shortly after the start, failed to factor. FUNKY COUNTRY was outrun early and raced five wide around the turn.
