**Footnotes**

LEADER OF THE LITE tracked the pace racing along the inside through the turn, angled to the two path hooking then moving past a weary WALTZING TIME clearing then digging in to hold off a wide closing COUNTESS CLAUDIA in the final yards. COUNTESS CLAUDIA slow early was swung out eight wide in upper stretch finding stride on the far outside finishing strong. THE GIRL ROLLS stalked the pace through the turn edging closer to loom boldly in the three path upper stretch, extending from the eighth pole would gradually weaken. CRYING THE BLUES slow early gave an inside move to contention in upper stretch then leveled off in the two path. FLYAWAY PRINCESS was hustled in pursuit through the turn, wavered in upper stretch fading from the six path. WALTZING TIME broke sharply to set the pace through the turn, began to shorten stride in upper stretch stopping abruptly inside the eighth pole. MISS HEN flashed early speed then gave way on the turn, raced seven and eight wide through the lane.
