Footnotes

MALKEINU rushed clear in the early going would steadily move off to a commanding lead in upper stretch, shown the whip was geared down late. DENIZEN raced evenly through the turn, bid between horses into upper stretch, emerged late in the three path to salvage place. WILD GOOSE CREEK slow early circled out to upper stretch, angled from the six to the five path vying evenly. BURNING LIGHT slow early came four wide in upper stretch improving modestly. U R DA BEST outrun through the turn raced mid track down the lane with little gain. EL QUIXOTE hustled in pursuit brushed with KIDS GOT SKILLS entering the turn, would weaken in upper stretch dropping off in the four path. KIDS GOT SKILLS brushed by EL QUIXOTE entering the turn would chase MALKEINU to upper stretch giving way there along the inside. RIGHT NICE labored throughout.
