**Footnotes**

WANDO ROCK LEE was never far off the pace racing off the rail, moved leaving the far turn, vied mid turn racing three wide abreast rivals, edged clear entering the stretch, was put to strong left handed stick mid stretch, brushed with BRACKINKNOWSALL in deep stretch holding determinedly. BRACKINKNOWSALL settled in the second flight racing in hand, bid in tandem leaving the far turn, loomed traveling in the four path top of the lane, almost drew even with the winner mid stretch, brushed with WANDO ROCK LEE in deep stretch and was eventually outgamed coming to the wire, settled for second best in a hard effort. RIVER CARD pressed for the lead soon after the start, vied in a three way battle mid turn running between foes, could not keep pace entering the lane, fought hard to win then battle for third place racing towards the inside. RAFEEKI stalked throughout, vied near the half running three wide, dropped off a bit in upper stretch, weakened inside the eighth pole dueling for the show position. WELL WHAT rated early racing mid track, mildly bid turning for home, soon leveled off never menacing. JAZZ AND BLUES trailed around the second turn, split foes in upper stretch improving placing, was no real factor. GO FAR FITZ was in tight entering the first turn, settled towards the rear, failed to respond when asked, no factor. PURGE TO PURGE angled to the rail shortly after the start, hustled up nearing the half to loom off the duelers, was all done past the three eighths pole giving way. BARRY MEATBALL set a pressured pace to the far turn, gave way on the bend, used up.
