ASHEN LORD stalked PRONTO CABALLO from the start, came four wide to engage that rival top of the lane, dueled in mid stretch running between foes, received strong left handed stick to edged away in deep stretch, won clear under a drive to the wire. WILLIE BAGS well placed early on, swung five wide upper stretch, raced abreast a pair of foes in mid stretch, was no match for the winner coming to the wire, finished a willing second. HAIL TO THE CHIEF bobbled at the break but quickly recovered, bid between foes on the bend, raced inside of top pair from mid stretch, closed willingly picking up the show position. YAROSLAV unhurried from the gate, saved ground to the quarter pole, gained momentum entering the stretch, swung out six wide upper stretch, showed best action too late improving placing but failed to threaten. ISSUES AND ANSWERS settled in the second flight, made a brief move at the quarter pole, chased into then lane, flattened out needing more in the drive. GOOD FAMILY trailed down the backside, gained along the inside mid turn, chased into the lane, weakened from mid stretch. PRONTO CABALLO hustled to the front, raced in the three path top of the lane, headed coming to the furlong marker, gave way at the sixteenth pole, used up. SPOKESMAN raced four to five wide down the backside traveling in the second flight, tired entering the stretch, no factor. ESSENCE THUNDER well placed from the start, began to give way leaving the quarter pole, no factor.
