FAVORITE PASSION was never far off the pace, bid four wide mid turn, vied in a three way battle at the quarter pole, edged clear in upper stretch, was hard ridden holding safe to the finish. NEED MONEY DAD stalked contested pace around the bend, came five wide receiving left handed whip top of the lane, could not quite get to the winner in deep stretch, proved a game second best. RILEY MCQ settled in the second flight, advanced entering the stretch to split foes in upper stretch, brushed a couple of times with MORE ADVICE at the eighth pole, continued on running along the rail finishing with interest. CHANGE PLEASE broke alertly, dueled racing between rivals throughout, battled to deep stretch, faded late, game try. SON OF A LUE settled in the second flight, came six wide top of the stretch, mildly gained but was no real threat. MOSES JEROME raced evenly along the rail to top of the stretch, angled out under a drive, failed to menace. DURANGO raced in mid pack, swung five wide into the lane, lacked needed response. MORE ADVICE showed good speed, dueled running along the rail to top of the stretch, was in close quarters and brushed with RILEY MCQ a couple of times in mid stretch and then checked hard, lost ground to the finish. BOMBAY was always outrun, never involved in a dull effort. CONSTANT VELOCITY struggled early, was outrun and pulled up on the turn. A STEWARDS INQUIRY CONCERNING THE STRETCH RUN WAS CONDUCTED, AFTER REVIEW, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN, RESULTS STOOD AS IS.
