CRAFTY TIME stalked close up through the turn bidding clear in the two path upper stretch, digging in late held firm to wire. TIME TIX AHEAD tracked the pace through the turn looming abreast the new leader in the three path upper stretch, making no headway on the winner salvaged place. MR. BRISTOL slow early angled from the two to the four path in upper stretch showing late interest. PAUL BUNYAN raced evenly in mid pack through the turn, circled out to the six path in upper stretch lacked needed late surge. VALLEYTAKEOVER was always a step slow. OH FRANKIE BABY chased through the turn then gave way at mid track in upper stretch. RHETORIC was always outrun. GIN KINGS sent clear set the pace along the inside through the turn, stopped badly inside the three sixteenths pole. WINDSOR CAT dropped back on the turn.
